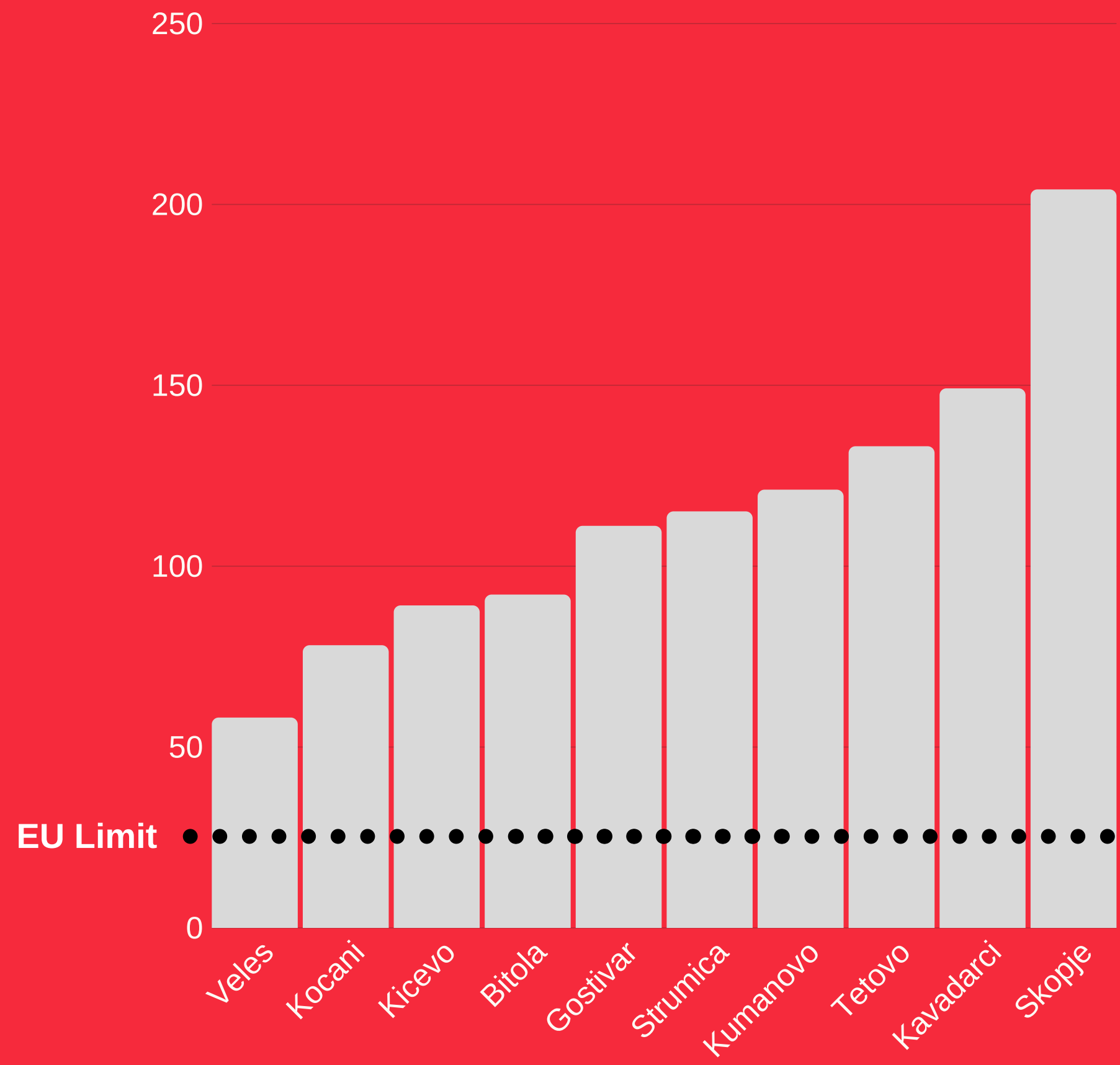

TOP POLLUTED CITIES

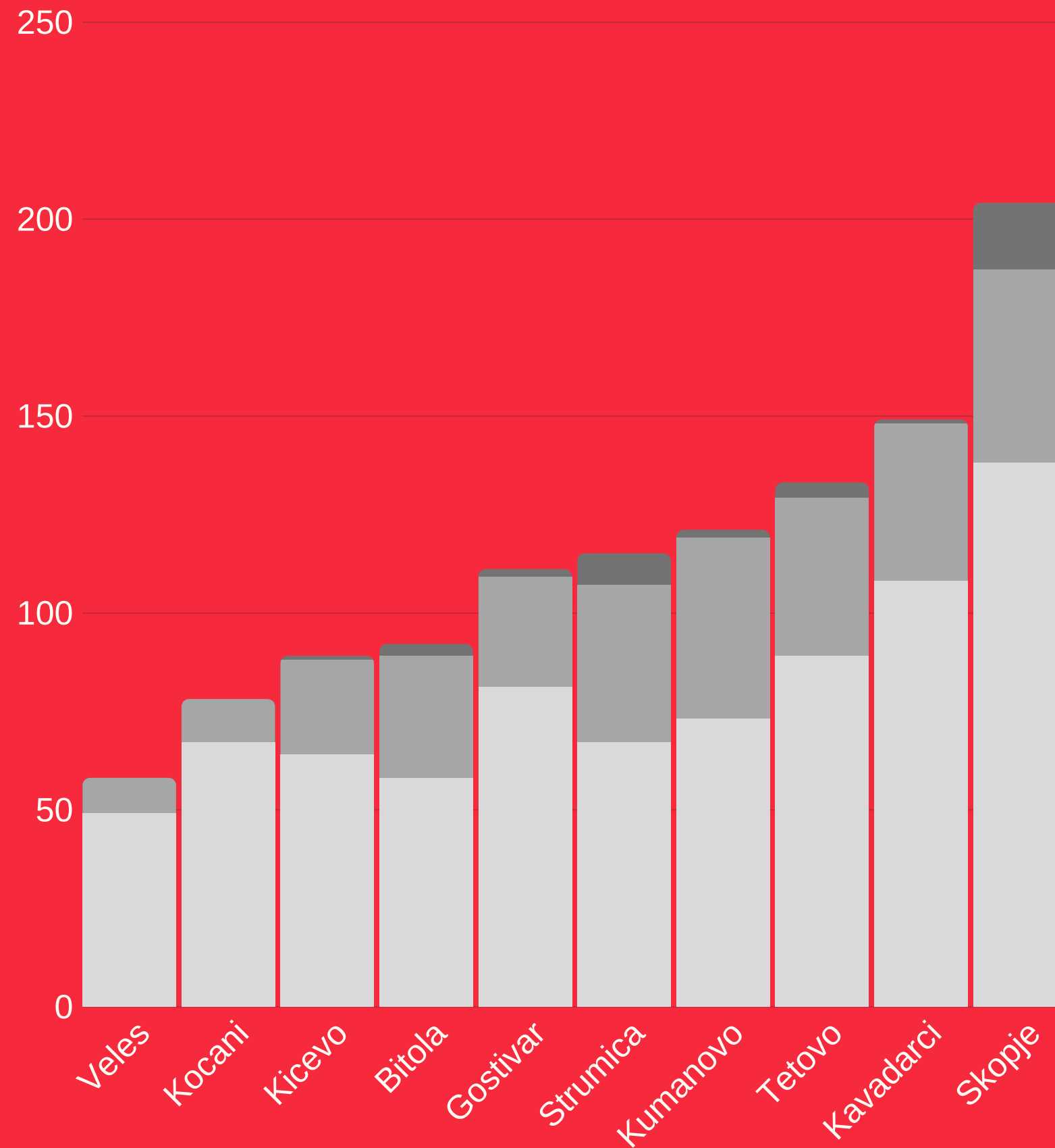
OF DAYS WITH AN AVERAGE PM10 CONCENTRATION OVER 50 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$

All cities where there is at least one government measuring station, have surpassed the EU limit of 35 days per calendar year where this value can be over 50 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$. For cities with multiple measuring stations, the one with the highest value is shown.



POLLUTION BREAKDOWN

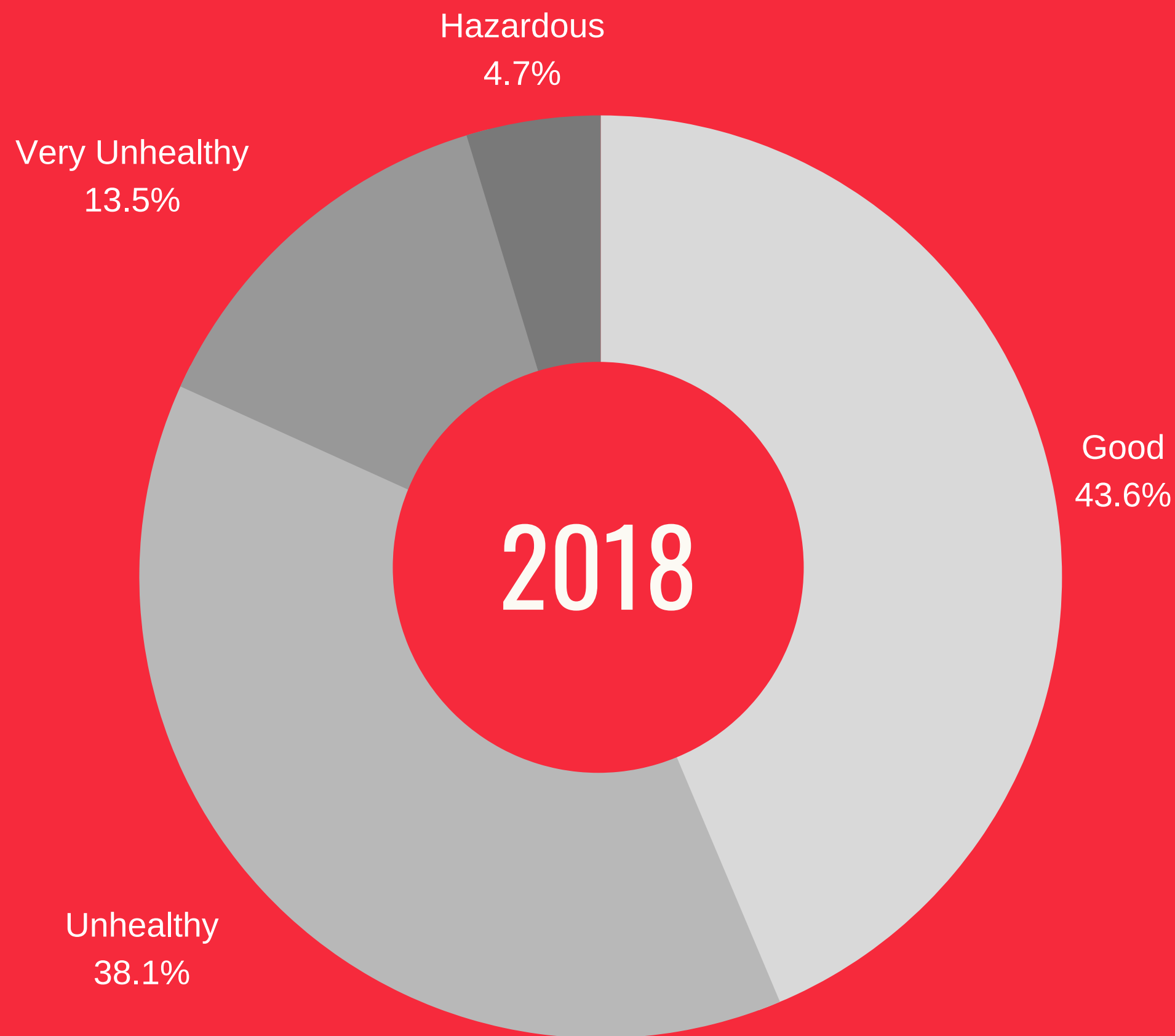
OF DAYS WITH AN AVERAGE PM10

AIR QUALITY OF 2018 BROKEN DOWN AS % OF DAYS OF THE YEAR

Data shows that in the capital of Macedonia, people breathe unhealthy air for over ½ of the year. The industry, wood & trash burning, and old vehicles contribute to this number.

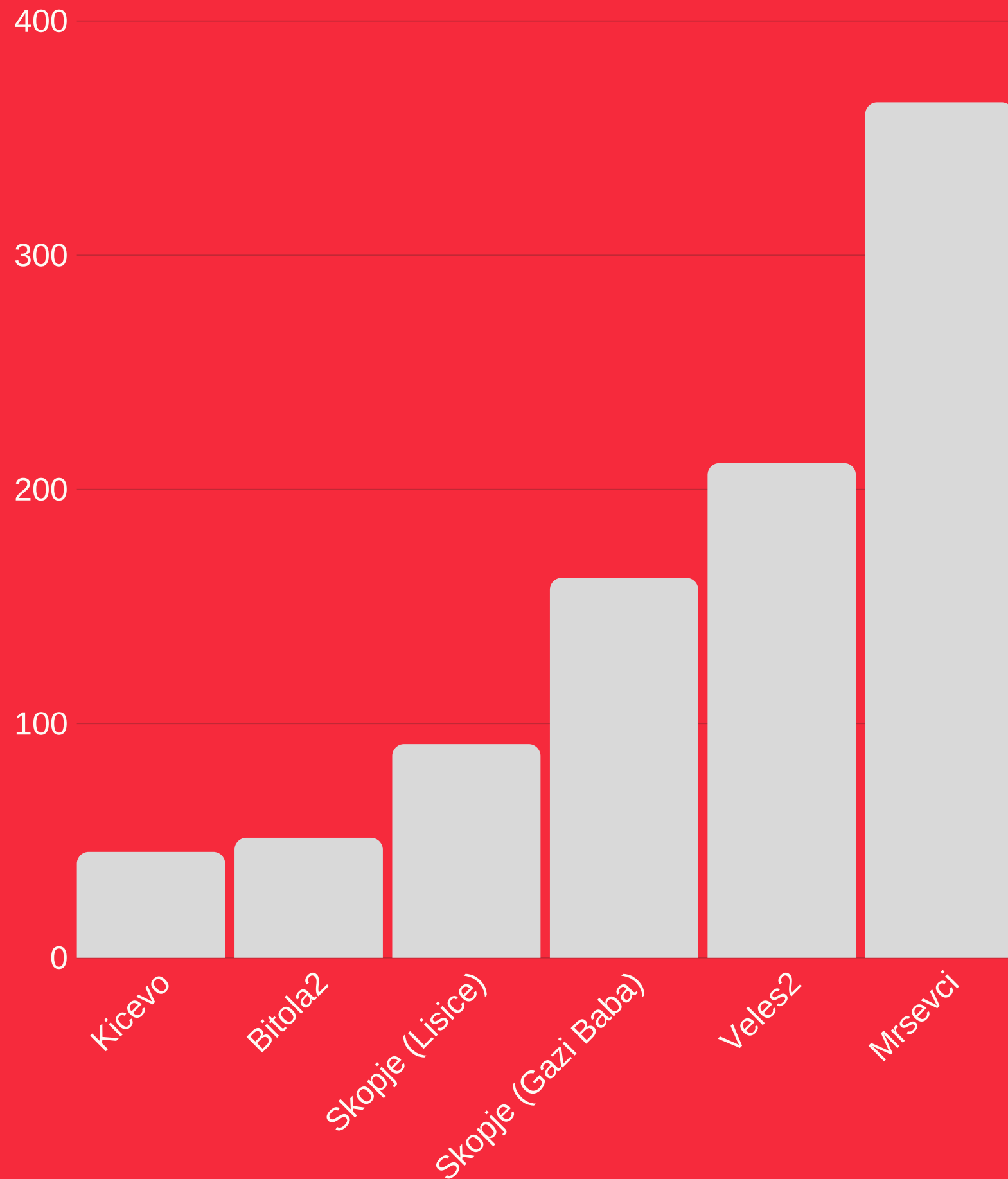


TOP MALFUNCTIONING STATIONS

OF DAYS OF TOP 6 STATIONS THAT HAVE NOT REPORTED PM10 DATA

We visualize only the top 6, but 16 of 18 government measuring stations have malfunctioned in 2018, not reporting PM10 data.

Stations in the most polluted areas of Skopje like "Lisice" and "Gazi Baba" have not been reporting data for a long time, scewing gov. reported averages to more favorable, yet false data.



WHAT NEXT?

This is a problem **YOU** are involved in and **YOU** can do something about it! Here are 3 actions you can take right now to insure we don't repeat this in 2019:

- 1 Contact your city officials, ask them what they plan to do about pollution in 2019. Get their plans, and ask them how they will report progress.
- 2 Don't accept *no* for an answer, submit a *freedom of information* request. They are legally required to give you the information.
- 3 Regularly follow up with them, email / phone / physical visits, keep the pressure active and demand action.
